
This Week in Congress June 4, 2018

The chamber will take up consideration of the 2018 water infrastructure bill (H.R. 8) as early as Wednesday. The reauthorization measure covers projects related to flood control, conservation, and waterway improvements, among other things.



FY19 APPROPRIATIONS BILLS

GOP leaders have put together the first FY 2019 "minibus" package, which covers the Energy-Water, Legislative Branch, and Milcon-VA spending bills. Passage is expected.





JUDICIAL NOMINATION

A cloture vote has been scheduled for 5:30 p.m. today on the nomination of Robert Earl Wier to be a U.S. district judge for the Eastern District of Kentucky.



DEFENSE REAUTHORIZATION AND WRDA

The chamber may take up consideration of its FY 2019 defense reauthorization bill and the 2018 water infrastructure bill (S. 2800).

On Wednesday, the House Financial Services Committee will hold a subcommittee hearing on "Improving Transparency and Accountability at the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection."



SEC AND CFTC APPROPRIATIONS HEARING

A Senate appropriations subcommittee will meet Tuesday to review the FY 2019 funding requests for the SEC and CFTC.
