#### \$5,000 Scholarships for Diverse First-Year Law Students

Consistent with the objective of promoting diversity in legal education and leadership roles in the legal profession, McGuireWoods will also consider additional criteria including, among other factors, whether the applicant is:

- The first family member to attend college.
- From an economically disadvantaged family.
- A member of a group currently underrepresented in law schools and law firms.
- From a family with little or no legal education or experience.
- An alumnus of a college or university whose graduates are historically underrepresented in law school.
- Demonstrating a strong commitment to promoting diversity in his or her undergraduate school, law school and community.

#### **Application Packet Contents**

- Completed application form.
- Current resume.
- Undergraduate & first semester law school transcripts (photocopy of official transcript is acceptable).
- Personal statement (limit of 1,500 words) explaining your commitment to diversity in the legal profession, community involvement and personal achievements. Tell us something that is not on your resume.
- Professional letter of recommendation from an undergraduate or law professor.

Completed application packet must be received by <u>May 25, 2018</u>. Scholarships will be awarded by July 2, 2018, paid directly to the law school for tuition and books only. Send materials via U.S. mail, e-mail or fax to:
