This interactive program uses hypotheticals to explore situations in which lawyers' interests might conflict with their clients' interests, including: lawyers' agreements to limit their practice, in partnership agreement non-competes, or in litigation settlements; lawyers selling their practice; lawyers limiting their liability to clients or resolving clients' claims (including agreements to arbitrate fee and malpractice disputes); lawyers' duties to former clients (including file ownership issues); non-clients' claims against lawyers.
