

Civil Rights and Diversity: Part II (Professionalism Issues)

This interactive program uses hypotheticals to explore numerous ethics issues facing lawyers advocating for civil rights and diversity. Among other things, the program will address: civil rights/diversity lawyers' public communications about their cases and about judges; litigation issues (including ghostwriting pleadings); discovery issues (including the ethical propriety of deceptive conduct designed to uncover discrimination); dealing with courts (including challenging court orders and existing law); judicial ethics (including judges' involvement with discriminatory organizations, and judicial bias).
