## Professionalism for the Ethical Lawyer

This interactive program uses hypotheticals to explore lawyers' balancing of their laudable desire to act professionally and their ethics duty to diligently serve their clients. Among other things, the program will address issues facing all lawyers (including the duty to supervise other lawyers, avoiding discrimination and bigotry, withdrawal in the face of clients' desire to pursue offensive conduct); issues primarily facing litigators (including the timing of filing pleadings and scheduling hearings, dealing with courts and their personnel, and offering evidence); issues primarily facing transactional lawyers (including collaborative lawyering, dealing with discourteous opponents, and reacting to adversaries' errors).
