## HOUSE



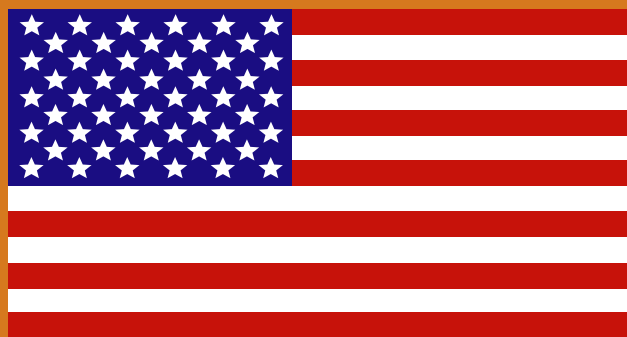
VOTE

Lawmakers will take up a series of homeland security and natural resources bills under suspension of the rules. A number of financial services measures are also on deck.



FOREIGN INVESTMENT RISK  
REVIEW MODERNIZATION ACT  
(FIRRMA)

The House will take up FIRRMA under suspension of the rules. The bill would overhaul operations at the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS) and reform current U.S. export controls.



IMMIGRATION PART II

The House is expected to take up consideration of the Border Security and Immigration Reform Act (H.R. 6136) – the “compromise” immigration bill that would, among other things, offer DACA recipients a pathway to citizenship.

## SENATE



FY 2019 APPROPRIATIONS

The Senate is expected to resume consideration of H.R. 5895, the “minibus” spending package that would cover Energy-Water, Legislative Branch, and Milcon-VA funding for fiscal year 2019. A final vote on the package is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. today.



FARM BILL

The chamber will also take its first procedural vote to kick off debate on the Senate version of the 2018 farm bill.



SENATE BANKING HEARINGS

The Senate Banking Committee will hold hearings on Tuesday and Thursday to discuss legislative proposals related to increasing access to capital and examining corporate governance.
